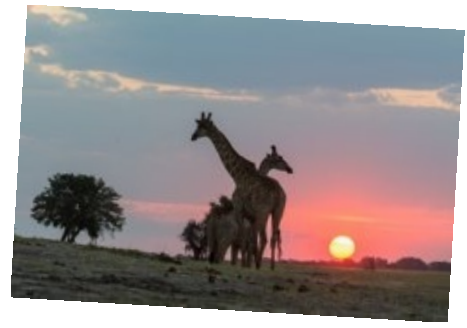


BOTSWANA STARS



Day 1 : Arrive Maun - Central Kalahari

On arrival in Maun you have a flight to your accommodation in the pristine oasis deep in the Kalahari desert of Botswana near the Okavango Delta.

Day 2 : Central Kalahari

During your stay experience the vastness of the Kalahari whilst enjoying abundant bird life, game viewing or star gazing. Let the San guides show you the tracking and survival skills of the San people. You learn how they gather food and how successful they are at hunting with their poisonous arrows.

Day 3 : Central Kalahari

Enjoy afternoon and night safaris for the best chance to see a variety of different species which include the magnificent Kalahari lion, cheetah, leopard as well as giraffe and kudu. The elusive brown hyena has also been seen on occasion. Night safaris reveal a fascinating world of nocturnal species. Deception Valley is also a bird lover's paradise.

Day 4 : Central Kalahari - Okavango Delta

Today leave the Kalahari for the Okavango Delta. Upon arrival of your scheduled flight transfer to Kanana. A hidden jewel on the Xudum River it is located in the southwest of the Okavango Delta.

Day 5 : Okavango Delta

After breakfast get to know the Okavango Delta's crystal clear waterways by motorboat and enjoy the magnificent variety of bird, plant and reptile species found in the area. Visit the Kanana Private Heronry, one of the largest breeding sights in Southern Africa.

Lodging: Kanana Camp

Day 6 : Okavango Delta

In the morning take a guided bush walk to gain a detailed understanding of this diverse environment which features gems like the red lechwe bounding through marshy areas, a kaleidoscope of birdlife plus predators and big game. Walks can also be taken on small islands where the extraordinary Pel's Fishing Owl is known to nest.

Day 7 : Okavango Delta - Chobe National Park

Today leave the Okavango Delta on a scheduled flight to Kasane. Upon arrival transfer to the Chobe Game Lodge. It is the only permanent lodge within the boundaries of Chobe National Park. This luxury lodge has a full eco-grading by the Botswana Tourism Board.

Day 8 : Chobe National Park

Today discover the wildlife of Chobe National Park which roams in abundance and diversity and is home to the largest concentration of elephants in Africa. During the dry season these large herds, as well as vast herds of buffalo, congregate along the fertile flood plains of the Chobe River where the animals come to drink, bathe and play. Lions, leopards, African wild dogs, puku, red lechwe, sables, giraffes and roan antelopes are often seen as well.

Day 9 : Chobe National Park

After breakfast get to know birding in Chobe National Park which is spectacular with Schalows turaco, barred owlet and white-browed coucal resident in the gardens as well as rosythroated longclaw, western-banded snake-eagle and hooded vulture among a few of the 450 species of the region. You can also choose to enjoy a guided boat tour later on.

Day 10 : Chobe National Park - Victoria Falls

After breakfast transfer to Victoria Falls. One of the original natural wonders of the world the falls are a World Heritage Site and locally known as 'The Smoke that Thunders'.

Day 11 : Victoria Falls

After breakfast you have time on your own to discover the area the famous Victoria Falls.

Day 12 : Victoria Falls Departure

After breakfast transfer to the Victoria Falls airport for your international return flight.
