

SOUTH AFRICA & VICTORIA FALLS



Day 1 : Arrive Cape Town

Upon arrival in Cape Town transfer to the hotel and time to relax from the flight. In the evening enjoy dinner at the famous Gold restaurant, a vibrant, eclectic Pan-African experience in the heart of Cape Town. It offers a night of opulent feasting with a unique bouquet of live entertainment in a mystical African setting of trees and tents.

Day 2 : Cape Town Harley Davidson Experience

Resting at the confluence of the Indian and Atlantic oceans, between the slopes of the iconic Table Mountain and the glistening sapphire waters of Table Bay, is the exceptionally scenic city of Cape Town. Day 3 : Cape Town - Paarl

It was named after the huge granite dome of rock, which overlooks the town founded in 1690. The famous 11-kilometre-long Main Street features the Strooidak Church, Die Oude Pastorie Museum and the Patriot Building.

Day 4 : Cape Winelands

Located at the foot of the Boland Mountains, the Cape Winelands is renowned for producing some of the world's finest wines. The breathtakingly beautiful landscape boasts incredible mountain scenery and numerous luxury wine farms laden with vineyards stretching across lush fertile valleys. Visitors can look forward to a variety of wonderful activities like exploring a collection of historic little hamlets and towns dotting the countryside and sampling a wide selection of world-class wines.

Day 5 : Cape Winelands - Hoedspruit

This morning starts with a domestic flight to Hoedspruit. Upon arrival transfer to Kapama Lodge. Sweeping views across a tranquil lake create a sentiment of feel-good as you arrive here. Thatched viewing decks overlooking the water ensure instant relaxation. You head out for your first game drive today as well.

Day 6 : Hoedspruit - Krueger National Park

Today you make your way to Krueger National Park. Stretching over more than two million hectares, it is one of the world's largest game reserves and a truly remarkable destination. Owing to its exceptional size, visitors are able to experience fantastic diversity, from changing scenery and ecosystems to an impressive array of animals, plant life and birdlife. A game drive is a spectacular experience here.

Day 7 : Krueger National Park - Livingstone Victoria Falls

This morning you have a domestic flight to Livingstone. Located a few kilometres from the Zambezi River in southwestern Zambia, this bustling town is famous for being the home of the magnificent Victoria Falls. One of the original natural wonders of the world, the site is known locally as 'The Smoke that Thunders'.

Day 8 : Livingstone Victoria Falls

On the banks of the Zambezi River, the Royal Livingstone Hotel is named after the legendary explorer who named Zambia's iconic waterfall in honour of his queen. As a guest here you enjoy the privilege of complimentary access to Victoria Falls via the hotels private entrance.

Day 9 : Victoria Falls

Resting on the southern banks of the Zambezi River at the western end of the eponymous falls, the town Victoria Falls is compact enough to walk around and makes an ideal base to explore the seventh wonder of the world. About two-thirds of the falls can be viewed from the Zimbabwean side.

Day 10 : Victoria Falls Departure
