

MOZAMBIQUE REVELATIONS



Day 1 : Arrive Nampula - Ilha de Mozambique

After arrival in Nampula transfer to the Ilha de Mozambique, located off the northern shore it is one of the country's lesser known treasures, a place where simplicity still reigns. With all the comforts of modern life you can get lost here in the stunning natural beauty, peaceful and friendly life and sense the adventures of the past.

Day 2 : Ilha de Mozambique

Today after breakfast you have a day at leisure to explore Ilha de Mozambique. In the 17th century, this small island served as a trading post controlled by colonialist powers. The ruling Portuguese bartered gold, ivory and, most significantly, slaves for silk, spices and other exotic goods. Much of the historical architecture from this era remains today and as a result, Ilha de Mozambique was declared a Unesco World Heritage site

Day 3 : Ilha de Mozambique - Gorongosa National Park

After breakfast transfer to Nampula airport for your domestic flight to Beira. Upon arrival make your way to the lodge, located in the Sofala province. This is the central area of Mozambique, at the south limit of the Great African Rift Valley, within the 4000 km² area of the Gorongosa National Park.

Day 4 : Gorongosa National Park Safari

Today you have an exciting game drive at the Gorongosa National Park. Its forests and savannahs are home to lions, hippos and elephants. Lake Urema and its surrounding wetlands and rivers attract scores of water birds. The multitiered Murombodzi Falls spills over jagged rocks on the slopes of Mount Gorongosa.

Day 5 : Gorongosa National Park Safari

This day is an opportunity to spend more time in the Gorongosa National park. Enjoy a sunset game drive and see more of the fascinating wildlife and stunning nature. Limestone gorges and bat-filled caves define the Cheringoma Plateau.

Day 6 : Gorongosa National Park - Vilanculos

Today after breakfast transfer to Vilanculos, a coastal town in the Vilanculos District of the Inhambane Province. Vilankulo is named after local tribal chief Gamela Vilankulo Mukoke, and some of the "bairros" are named after his sons.

Day 7 : Vilanculos - Bazaruto Island Tour

This day visit various islands and coral reefs in the Bazaruto Archipelago. The aim is to ensure conservation of the natural and cultural heritage of the area and creating unforgettable leisure and educational opportunities on this dhow-based adventure and share a greater understanding of the importance of the Bazaruto Archipelago.

Day 8 : Vilanculos

Today you have the opportunity to relax and marvel at the azure waters of the Indian Ocean. You can browse for fresh produce and locally-made souvenirs in the bustling market in the centre of town or spend the day soaking up the sun on an array of idyllic beaches. Other popular activities include: horse riding, kitesurfing, scuba diving, snorkelling and sailing.

Day 9 : Vilanculos

After breakfast today enjoy another day at leisure. Cool off in the pool or wander down through the private gardens to the water's edge where the locals anchor their fishing dhows and land their catch. Friendly people, unspoiled ambiance and stunning scenery, this is the real Mozambique!
