



OMAN DELIGHTS

Day 1: Arrival in Muscat

Welcome to Oman! On arrival at Muscat International Airport, you'll be greeted and transferred to your hotel. Take the evening to rest and breathe in the warm Arabian air—the adventure begins tomorrow.

Day 2: Discovering Muscat

Begin your exploration of Oman's capital with a visit to the magnificent Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque, a masterpiece of Islamic architecture. Drive along the corniche, where sea breezes meet the bustle of daily life, and step into the Bait Al Zubair Museum, home to treasures that tell Oman's story through art and heritage. Pause for a photo at the elegant Al Alam Palace, framed by the Portuguese forts of Mirani and Jalali, before wandering through the vibrant alleys of Muttrah Souq, where the scent of frankincense and the sparkle of silver fill the air.

Day 3: Coastal Wonders to Sur

Travel by 4WD along one of Oman's most breathtaking coastal routes. Azure waters stretch out to the horizon while pristine white-sand beaches line the way. Visit the Bimah Sinkhole, a limestone wonder with jewel-toned waters.. At Wadi Tiwi, lush date palms and flowing streams reveal a green paradise amid rugged cliffs. After a picnic lunch, continue to Sur, where by nightfall a magical encounter awaits: watching giant sea turtles nesting on the beach under a canopy of stars.

Day 4: From Desert Sands to Nizwa

Today's journey blends oases and desert dreams. Explore the sparkling pools of Wadi Bani Khalid, an oasis hidden in the mountains, before venturing into the sweeping dunes of the Wahiba Sands. Experience the rhythm of Bedouin life with a traditional visit, a camel ride, and a thrilling dune drive. As the day ends, travel onward to Nizwa, Oman's cultural heart.

Day 5: Heritage of Nizwa and Beyond

Step back in time in Nizwa Souq, where pottery, silver, and golden treasures are still traded. Visit the imposing Nizwa Fort with its iconic round tower, then wander the ancient village of Al Hamra, home to 400-year-old mud-brick houses still standing strong. Continue to Bahla, famed for its pottery and aura of mystique, before exploring the 17th-century Jabrin Castle, renowned for its intricate carvings, painted ceilings, and artistry.

Day 6: Flight to Salalah

After breakfast, transfer to Seeb Airport for your flight to Salalah, in the lush south of Oman. Arrive and settle into your hotel, with time to relax by the sea.

Day 7: Legends of Salalah

Discover the ancient history of Dhofar, tracing Oman's story back 5,000 years. Visit the old town of Taqa before arriving at the ruins of Sumhurum, once linked to the Queen of Sheba and the thriving frankincense trade. Wander through Mirbat, a village echoing with Omani tradition, and later explore the ruins of Al Balid. Journey on to Mughsail Beach, where blowholes shoot seawater into the sky, and pass through frankincense groves where the air is perfumed by Oman's most precious gift. End the day with a visit to the tomb of Prophet Job, high in the Dhofar mountains.

Day 8: The Spirit of Dhofar & Farewell to Oman

This morning, stroll through Salalah's garden farms, where coconut palms and papaya groves flourish. Stop for photos at the striking Shanfari Mosque, admire the royal Al Husn Palace, and wander the lively Al Husn Souq, alive with the scent of frankincense. A final stop at the Al Balid Museum offers insight into Dhofari traditions before flying back to Muscat. Your last evening is a highlight: a farewell dhow cruise across Muscat's bay, as the city lights shimmer and the sea reflects your journey through magical Oman.

Day 9: Departure

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight home, carrying with you the scents, colors, and timeless memories of Oman.
