Day 1: Arrive in Cape Town

Arrive in Cape Town, where you'll be warmly welcomed and transferred to your hotel. Take time to relax and settle in after your journey.

Day 2: Cape Peninsula Adventure

Set out on a full-day excursion along the breathtaking Cape Peninsula. Travel the scenic coastal road to Hout Bay and on to the dramatic cliffs of Chapman's Peak Drive. Explore Cape Point National Park at the very tip of Africa before visiting the charming African penguins at Boulders Beach. Return to Cape Town in the evening.

Day 3: Table Mountain & Robben Island

This morning, ride the cable car up Table Mountain (weather permitting) for spectacular views across the city and coast. Spend the afternoon shopping at the lively V&A Waterfront or take an optional visit to historic Robben Island, where Nelson Mandela spent 18 of his 27 years in prison.

Day 4: Stellenbosch & the Winelands

Journey into the Cape Winelands, where vineyards and mountains create postcard-perfect scenery. Discover the French influence in Franschhoek, stroll through historic Stellenbosch, and admire Cape Dutch architecture. Enjoy a guided wine tasting and learn what makes this region one of the world's most celebrated.

Day 5: Cape Town – Hoedspruit Kruger Region

Fly from Cape Town to Hoedspruit, gateway to Kruger National Park. On arrival, transfer to your lodge and unwind in a completely new environment surrounded by wilderness.

Day 6: Safari in Kruger National Park

Rise early for a thrilling 4x4 safari in Kruger National Park, one of Africa's most iconic reserves. With luck, you'll spot the "Big Five"—lion, leopard, rhino, elephant, and buffalo—alongside countless other species and vibrant birdlife.

Day 7: Hazyview – Kruger National Park

After breakfast, continue to Hazyview and your next lodge. In the afternoon, head back into Kruger for another safari in a different region of the park, offering fresh chances for unforgettable wildlife sightings.

Day 8: Into Eswatini Swaziland

Travel onward to Eswatini, a kingdom rich in culture and tradition. Stop at a cultural village to learn about Swazi life in the 1850s before walking through the beautiful Mantenga Nature Reserve.

Day 9: Eswatini Heritage & Nature

Start the day with a township visit to experience modern Swazi life and traditions. Later, continue to Mlilwane Wildlife Sanctuary—the country's oldest protected reserve—where wildlife and cultural heritage meet in a unique conservation setting.

Day 10: Departure from Johannesburg

Cross the border back into South Africa and transfer to Johannesburg airport for your international flight home, carrying with you the soul of Southern Africa—its wildlife, culture, and warm spirit.
